

List of card game safety warnings based on the requirements of General Product Safety Regulation (EU) 2023/988 (GPSR):

* Beware of sharp card edges that may cause cuts. Pay close attention to the condition of the cards, especially if they are old or damaged. * Do not allow young children to play with cards without supervision. There is a risk of swallowing small parts or choking. * Protect your cards from moisture and flooding. Wet cards can be slippery and difficult to hold, which increases the risk of accidents. * Avoid bending or breaking cards. Damaged cards can pose a threat, especially if they are swallowed or if sharp elements separate from the card. * Be careful when shuffling cards. Incorrect shuffling can lead to card damage or hand injuries. * Regularly check the condition of your cards to ensure they are not damaged or destroyed. Damaged cards should be discarded to avoid potential hazards. * Once the game is over, keep your cards safe and secure, out of reach of children and pets. * If the cards are intended for a specific age group, make sure the players meet the age requirements. * If you experience any health problems during or after using the cards, consult your doctor. * If the cards have electronic components, e.g. batteries, please follow the safety instructions. Batteries can be dangerous if swallowed.
