

List of safety warnings for battle systems based on the requirements of General Product Safety Regulation (EU) 2023/988 (GPSR):

1. Choking risk:

- Some models may contain small components that may pose a choking hazard to young children.

Keep out of reach of children under 3 years of age. 2. Sharp edges and tips:

- Pay attention to sharp edges or tips on models. They can cause cuts or other injuries. Be careful when assembling and using. 3. Safety of paints and materials:

- Make sure that the paints and adhesives used to assemble and paint the models are non-toxic and safe for users. Avoid inhaling fumes and contact with skin. 4. Eye injuries:

- When painting models with aerosol, always wear safety glasses to avoid irritation or eye damage.

5. Fire hazard:

- Some materials may be flammable. Keep models away from heat sources and open fire. 6. Risk of falling:

- Store models, especially larger ones, in a stable place to prevent them from falling and potential injuries. 7. Electronic components (if applicable):

- For models with electronic components, follow the manufacturer's instructions for safe use and maintenance. Avoid contact with water and improper power supply. 8. Magnets (if applicable):
